- (a) A sum not exceeding £3,081,190, payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of November and December or following month of the financial year ending 30th June, 1937, to be expended at the rates which are shown on the Estimates for the financial year ending 30th June, 1937, as laid upon the Table of the House, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1936-1937.
- (b) A sum not exceeding £2,112,660, payable out of the Government Railways Fund, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses, and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of November and December or following month of the financial year ending 30th June, 1937, to be expended at the rates which are shown on the Estimates for the financial year ending 30th June, 1937, as laid upon the Table of the House, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1936-1937.
