For the first time, eventgoers will be able to experience Vivid Ideas at Australia's oldest Parliament as part of Vivid Sydney 2022.

NSW Parliament House will offer a dynamic program of public events, including conversations with and performances by some of Australia's best-known comedians and a panel discussion that invites politicians to bare their souls.

Vivid Ideas 2022 at NSW Parliament House includes:

- "The Bare Pit" on 31 May, in association with The Ethics Centre, will see a panel of MPs, journalists and commentators share their experiences and tackle the question, "What place does religion have in politics?"
- "The Even Greater Sydney Planning Committee" on Wednesday 8 and Thursday 9 June, a live rendition of the HG Nelson and James Valentine satirical ABC Radio podcast, formed when the duo realised what Sydney needed was one more body devoted to Sydney planning.
- "The Gospel According to Paul" on Wednesday 8 and Thursday 9 June, a hilarious theatrical take on former Prime Minister Paul Keating's life by actor, writer, director and political satirist Jonathan Biggins.
