the route over which the passengers or goods are so carried is
such a route.
- 10 (2) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of subsection
one of this section is guilty of an offence against this Act and is liable
for a first offence to a penalty of not less than five hundred pounds nor
more than one thousand pounds, for a second offence to a penalty of
not less than five thousand pounds nor more than ten thousand pounds,
and for a third or subsequent offence to a penalty of not less than ten
15 thousand pounds nor more than twenty thousand pounds.

Mr. Maddison brought up the following new clause to stand as clause 9 of the Bill:—

- 1 9. (1) Any person aggrieved by—
- (i) a refusal of the Commissioner to grant a licence under Section 6 of this Act, or
- (ii) the revocation variation or suspension of a licence
- 5 by the Commissioner under Section 8 of this Act,
- may elect to appeal to a single judge of the Supreme Court of New South Wales.
- (2) (a) An appeal under Section 12A of this Act shall be by way of hearing in open court and the court will have regard to the matters provided in Section 6 of this Act.
- 10 (b) In deciding an appeal under this Section the court may confirm, vary or reverse the decision of the Commissioner and may by order direct the Commissioner to take such action as is necessary to give effect to the court's decision.
- 15 (c) The court may make such order as to the costs of an appeal as the court thinks fit.

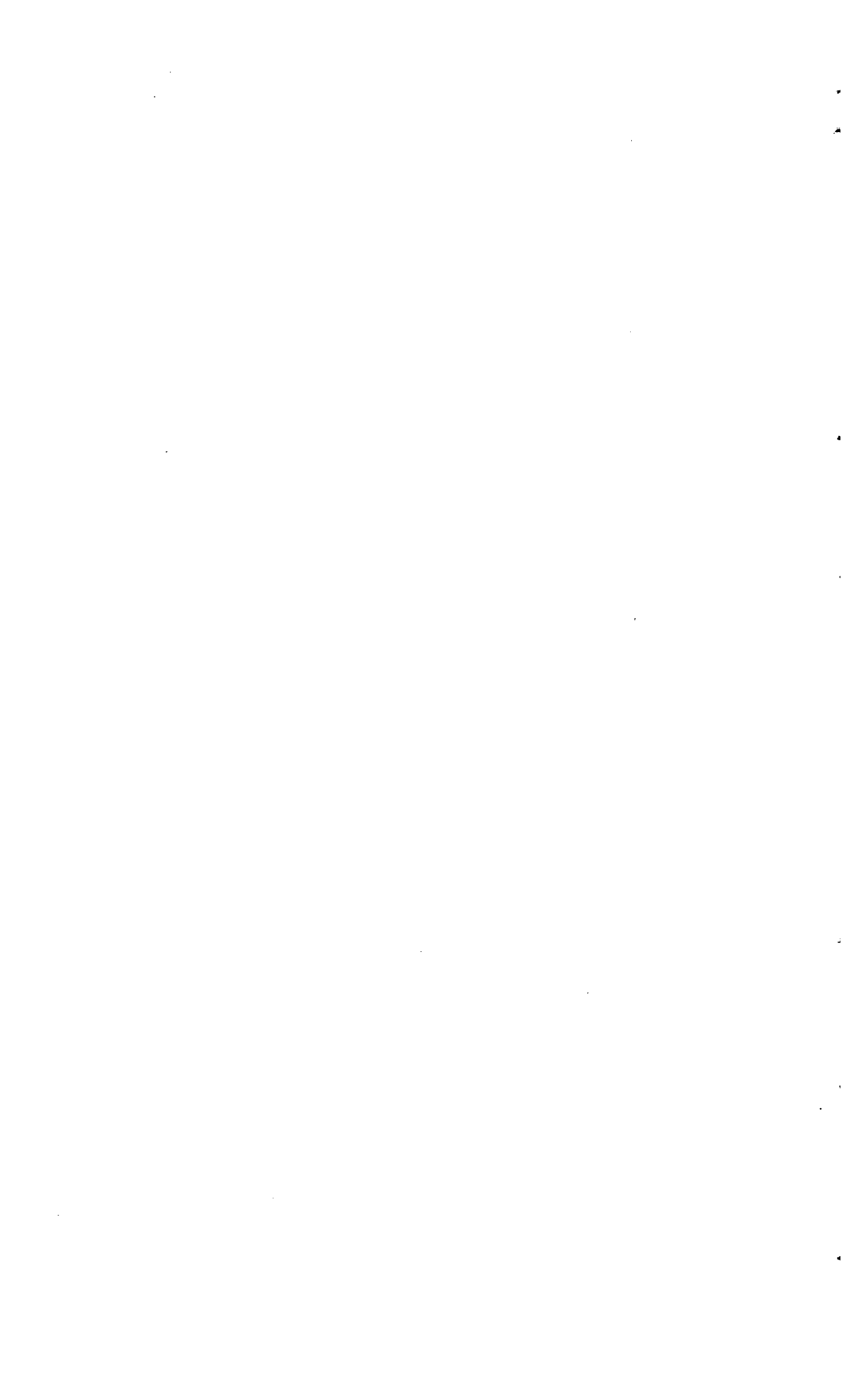
