15 (3) Notwithstanding anything in subsection (1), in determining the land value of any land, being land in relation to which, at the date to which the valuation relates, there was a right or other authority pursuant to the Water Act, 1912, or any other Act or law to take or use water—

(a) the land value shall include the value of the right or other authority; and

(b) it shall be assumed that the right or other authority shall continue to apply in relation to the land.

Clauses 1 to 3 having been dealt with,—

Clause 4.

Issue of commission.

5 4. (1) The Governor may, by letters patent under the Public Seal of the State, being letters patent expressed to be made or issued under the authority of this Act, issue a commission to a person specified in the commission—

(a) authorising or requiring the person to inquire into and report to the Governor on any matter specified in the commission; and

(b) establishing a Special Commission of Inquiry for that purpose.

10 (2) A commission may not be issued to a person who is not a Judge or Queen's Counsel, but (subject to revocation, alteration or variation by the Governor) continues in force notwithstanding that the person ceases to be a Judge or Queen's Counsel after it is issued.

15 (3) The provisions of this Act apply to and in respect of a commission issued under this Act.

(4) The Royal Commissions Act, 1923, does not apply to or in respect of a commission issued under this Act or any inquiry held in relation to it.

15 (3) Where a Commissioner directs that a hearing to be held by the Commissioner take place in private, the Commissioner may give directions as to the persons who may be present at the hearing.

(4) Where, at a hearing by a Commissioner that is held in public, the Commissioner is satisfied that it is desirable to do so by reason of the confidential nature of any evidence or matter or for any other reason, the Commissioner may direct that the hearing or a part of the hearing take place in private and give directions as to the persons who may be present.
