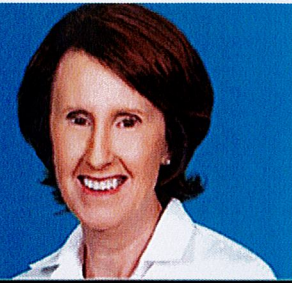

Dear Mr Speaker,

I submit the following Public Interest Debate Topic for Wednesday 8 May 2024.

Topic: Domestic Violence Frontline Workers

That this House:

1. Notes that the Federal Government committed \$17.118 million in funding for NSW in 2022-23 and 2023-24 to recruit 118 additional frontline domestic violence workers under the National Partnership Agreement on Family, Domestic and Sexual Violence Responses 2021-27;
2. Notes that since signing up to the National Partnership Agreement the NSW Labor Government has delivered only five of these additional 118 funded frontline domestic violence workers;
3. Call on the Premier and the Minister for the Prevention of Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault to deliver the 113 frontline domestic violence workers they committed to ahead of the 30 June deadline so victim-survivors in NSW aren't left behind.
