SELECTION OF BILLS COMMITTEE

The Selection of Bills Committee met on Tuesday 24 November to consider whether the following bills be referred to a standing committee for inquiry and report:

- Appropriation Bill 2020
- Appropriation (Parliament) Bill 2020
- Payroll Tax Amendment Bill 2020
- Crimes (Domestic and Personal Violence) Amendment (Coercive and Controlling Behaviour) Bill 2020.
