PROCLAMATION

NEW SOUTH WALES

By His Excellency, the Honourable Gordon
Samuels, Companion of the Order of Australia,
Governor of the State of New South Wales in the
Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly now stand adjourned: NOW I, in pursuance of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution Act 1902, do today prorogue the said Legislative Council and the said Legislative Assembly on and from Wednesday 11 August 1999 to 2.15 o'clock in the afternoon of Tuesday 7 September 1999.

I further proclaim that the said Legislative Council and also the Legislative Assembly shall assemble for the despatch of business on Tuesday 7 September 1999, at 2.15 o'clock in the afternoon, in the premises known as Parliament House, Macquarie Street, Sydney: And the Members of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly are hereby required to attend at that time and place.
