WHEREAS the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly now stand adjourned: NOW I, in pursuance of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution Act 1902, hereby prorogue the said Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly to Monday, the 15th day of September, 1997; and I proclaim that the said Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly shall assemble for the despatch of business on Tuesday, the 16th of September, 1997, at 2.10 p.m., in the premises known as Parliament House, Macquarie Street, Sydney: And the Members of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly are hereby required to attend at that time and place.
