Proposed amendments

- No. 1 **Multi-occasion extended trading authorisations**
Page 8, Schedule 1 [30], line 20. Omit “12”. Insert instead “10”.
- No. 2 **Multi-occasion extended trading authorisations**
Page 8, Schedule 1 [31], line 25. Omit “12”. Insert instead “10”.
- No. 3 **Prevention of excessive alcohol consumption**
Pages 11 and 12, Schedule 1 [48] and [49], line 36 on page 11 to line 5 on page 12. Omit all words on those lines.
- No. 4 **Disclosures concerning exemptions to patron ID scanning in Kings Cross precinct**
Page 14, Schedule 1. Insert after line 22:
- (11) If the Minister grants an application for an exemption under subsection (7) with respect to a patron ID scanning requirement for a high risk venue located in the Kings Cross precinct, the Minister is to cause the following to be published on the website of the Office of Liquor, Gaming and Racing, Department of Trade and Investment, Regional Infrastructure and Services:
 - (a) the name of the licensee who made the application,
 - (b) the names of any persons or bodies that made submissions to the Minister in connection with the application,
 - (c) a copy of the exemption that was granted.
- No. 5 **Establishment of local liquor accords**
Page 17, Schedule 1 [63], lines 22 and 23. Omit all words on those lines. Insert instead:
- (1) Subject to subsection (1A), any 2 or more eligible parties (at least one of whom is a licensee) may enter into a local liquor accord.
 - (1A) The Commissioner of Police may, by notice in writing, direct one or more licensees to enter into a local liquor accord with specified eligible parties within the period specified by the notice.
 - (1B) It is taken to be a condition of the licence of each licensee directed under subsection (1A) to enter into a local liquor accord that the licensee comply with the direction within the period specified in the direction.
