71 Monitoring of enforcement conditions by Ombudsman

- (1) For the period of 2 years from the date of commencement of the *Bail Amendment (Enforcement Conditions) Act* 2012, the Ombudsman is to keep under scrutiny:
 - (a) the imposition of enforcement conditions on grants of bail to accused persons under section 37AA, and
 - (b) the exercise of powers conferred on police officers under that section.
- (2) For that purpose, the Ombudsman may require the Commissioner of Police or any other public authority to provide information about those matters.
- (3) The Ombudsman must, as soon as practicable after the end of the 2-year period, prepare a report on those matters and furnish a copy of the report to the Minister.
- (4) The reports are to be tabled by the Minister in each House of Parliament as soon as practicable after they are received by the Minister.
- (5) If a House of Parliament is not sitting when the Minister seeks to table a report, copies of the report are to be presented to the Clerk of the House concerned by the Minister.
- (6) The report:
 - (a) is, on presentation and for all purposes, taken to have been laid before the House, and
 - (b) may be printed by authority of the Clerk of the House, and

- (c) if so printed, is for all purposes taken to be a document published by or under the authority of the House, and
- (d) is to be recorded:
 - i) in the case of the Legislative Council, in the Minutes of the Proceedings of the Legislative Council, and
 - (ii) in the case of the Legislative Assembly, in the Votes and Proceedings of the Legislative Assembly,

on the first sitting day of the House after receipt of the report by the Clerk.
