

Motor Accidents Amendment (Board of Directors) Bill 1997

Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

Overview of Bill

The Motor Accidents Act 1988 currently provides that the Board of Directors of the Motor Accidents Authority is to consist of the General Manager of the Authority and 7 part-time directors.

The object of this Bill is to amend section 84 of that Act to alter the number of part-time directors on the Board to provide for a minimum of 7 and a maximum of 10 part-time directors so as to enable additional part-time directors to be appointed to the Board.

Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name (also called the short title) of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act on a day to be appointed by proclamation.

Clause 3 is a formal provision that gives effect to the amendments to the *Motor Accidents Act 1988* set out in Schedule 1.

Schedule 1 [1] and [2] amend section 84 of the *Motor Accidents Act 1988* in the manner described in the Overview above.

Schedule 1 [3] makes a consequential amendment to Schedule 2 to the Act relating to the quorum for a meeting of the Board.

Schedule 1 [4] amends Schedule 4 to the Act to provide that the amendments to section 84 do not affect the appointment or term of office of an existing part-time director.

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Motor Accidents Amendment (Board of Directors) Act 1997.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on a day to be appointed by proclamation.
