Drug Misuse and Trafficking Amendment (Appointed Persons) Bill 2023

Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to amend the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985* to—

- (a) provide that certain persons may appoint a person to give certificate evidence relating to the result of a plant or substance analysis, and
- (b) provide that appointments made before the commencement of the proposed Act are taken to be, and always to have been, validly made.

Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name, also called the short title, of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act.

Schedule 1 Amendment of Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985 No 226

Schedule 1[1] allows the Executive Director under the *Royal Botanic Gardens and Domain Trust Act 1980*, and other persons prescribed by the regulations, to appoint a person to give certificates relating to the result of a plant or substance analysis if the Executive Director or prescribed person considers the person to be suitably qualified.

Schedule 1[6] inserts a validation provision to provide that an appointment purported to have been made before the commencement of the proposed Act is taken to be, and always to have been, a valid appointment and that an evidentiary certificate given by a person whose appointment is

validated by the provision is taken to be, and always to have been, validly given. **Schedule** 1[2]–[5] make consequential amendments to insert part headings into Schedule 3.
