David Berry Hospital Amendment (Prohibition of Sale) Bill 2024

Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to prohibit the sale or disposal of the lands on which the David Berry Hospital stands.

Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name, also called the short title, of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act on the date of assent to the proposed Act.

Schedule 1 Amendment of David Berry Hospital Act 1906 No 53

Schedule 1 provides that the Crown, or another person, must not sell or dispose of lands vested in the Crown under the *David Berry Hospital Act 1906* and used as the site of the David Berry Hospital.
