 [1A] Section 3(b) and note
 Omit “pest” wherever occurring. Insert instead “invasive non-native”.
- No. 2 **Right to hunt**
Page 4, Schedule 1[8], lines 3–20. Omit all words on the lines.

Page 4, Schedule 1[8], proposed section 4B(3), line 24. Omit all words on the line. Insert instead—
 (a) existing uses of the land for hunting,

 (2) The person nominated by the Secretary under subsection (1)(e) must be the person employed in the Department who, in the Secretary’s opinion, has primary responsibility for the regulation of hunting in accordance with this Act.
- No. 11 **Functions of Conservation Hunting Authority**
Page 5, Schedule 1[10], proposed section 9(1). Insert after line 36—
 (a1) to commission and consider peer reviewed scientific submissions on the efficacy of recreational hunting and professional hunting in controlling and reducing the impact of invasive non-native species,
- No. 12 **Liaison functions**
Page 6, Schedule 1[10], proposed section 9(1)(e), line 1. Insert “and the National Parks and Wildlife Service established under the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974*” after “Local Land Services”.

 (1) A restricted game hunting licence that was in force immediately before the commencement day is taken to be a conservation hunting licence.
 (2) The holder of a licence that is, under this section, taken to be a conservation hunting licence who within 6 months after the commencement day applies to the Regulatory Authority for the issue of a conservation hunting licence is exempt from the requirement to pay an application fee in connection with the application.
 (3) A licence that is, under this section, taken to be a conservation hunting licence is cancelled on the day that is 6 months after the commencement day.
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- No. 19 **Designated land**
Page 10, Schedule 3[1], proposed section 9A.3, lines 15–33. Omit all words on the lines. Insert instead—
- 9A.3 Minister must give notice of designated land**
- (1) The Minister must give the public notice of designated land by prominently displaying on the Department’s website—
- (a) a searchable map of the state showing all designated land, and
- (b) a list, by local government area, of all designated land including the area in hectares of each parcel of designated land.
- (2) The regulations may prescribe additional matters that must be included in the list of designated land required under subsection (1)(b).
- No. 20 **Plans of management**
Page 11, Schedule 3[1], proposed section 9A.7. Insert after line 32—
- (1A) Before preparing or reviewing a plan of management under subsection (1), the responsible land manager must consult land users.
- No. 21 **Plans of management**
Page 11, Schedule 3[1], proposed section 9A.7. Insert after line 34—
- (2A) Before adopting a plan of management prepared or reviewed under this section, the responsible land manager must publicly display the proposed plan for a minimum of 30 days and invite submissions from land users.
- No. 22 **Review**
Page 12, Schedule 3[1], proposed section 9A.8(2), lines 30 and 31. Omit all words on the lines. Insert instead—
- (2) When conducting the review the Minister must—
- (a) consult with the Conservation Hunting Authority, and
- (b) consult the general public.
- No. 23 **Commencement of review**
Page 12, Schedule 3[1], proposed section 9A.8(3), lines 32 and 33. Omit “5 years”. Insert instead “12 months”.
- No. 24 **Tabling of review**
Page 12, Schedule 3[1], proposed section 9A.8. Insert after line 33—
- (4) The Minister must table a report of the review in both houses of Parliament within 18 months after the commencement of this part.
- No. 25 **Designated land**
Page 12, Schedule 3[2], line 37. Omit “sections 9A.2 and 9A.3”. Insert instead “section 9A.2”.
