Local Court Amendment (Jurisdiction) Bill 2025

Act No , 2025

An Act to amend the *Local Court Act 2007* in relation to the Local Court's jurisdiction regarding subject matter; and for related purposes.

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts—

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Local Court Amendment (Jurisdiction) Act 2025*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the date of assent to this Act.

[1] Section 33 Certain jurisdiction excluded

Insert after section 33(1)(c)—

- (d) proceedings for invasion of privacy or other privacy contravention, including proceedings for administrative review under the *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998*, section 55,

[2] Section 33(1A)

Insert after section 33(1)—

- (1A) Subsection (1)(d) does not apply to proceedings for invasion of privacy or other privacy contravention if the proceedings are of a class prescribed by the regulations for this subsection.
- (1B) Despite the *Civil and Administrative Tribunal Act 2013*, section 34D(1), subsection (1)(d) prevails to the extent of any inconsistency between that paragraph and the *Civil and Administrative Tribunal Act 2013*, Part 3A.

Part Provision consequent on enactment of Local Court Amendment (Jurisdiction) Act 2025

Existing proceedings

- (1) If, immediately before the commencement, pending proceedings had been heard or partly heard, the pending proceedings may continue to be dealt with and determined by the Local Court as if the amendment Act had not commenced.
- (2) If, immediately before the commencement, pending proceedings had not commenced to be heard, from the commencement the pending proceedings are—
 - (a) taken to have been commenced in the District Court, and
 - (b) to be heard and determined in the District Court.
- (3) In this clause—

amendment Act means the *Local Court Amendment (Jurisdiction) Act 2025*.

commencement means the commencement of the amendment Act.

pending proceedings means proceedings for invasion of privacy or other privacy contravention, including proceedings for administrative review under the *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998*, section 55, commenced in the Local Court but not finalised.

Section 34D Relationship of Part to this Act and other laws
