**Repeal of restriction on licence terms**

- (1) This clause applies to a licence granted on or from the repeal date.

  - (a) a reference to a period of 2 years in section 21(1) in relation to the period of time a licence continues in force must be taken to be a reference to 5 years, and
  - (b) a reference to 2 years in section 21(2)(a) in relation to the period of time a category D licence continues in force must be taken to be a reference to 2 years or 5 years, and
  - (c) the *Firearms Regulation 2017*, section 8 as in force immediately before the commencement of the amendment Act applies.
- (3) In this clause—  
*repeal date* is the day on which section 21(1) is amended by the amendment Act.

- (2) A public assembly restriction declaration in force immediately before the repeal date is taken to be revoked on the repeal date if not earlier revoked or otherwise ceases to have effect.
- (3) In this section—  
*repeal date* means the day on which this division is repealed under subsection (1).
