# Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Bill 2026

## Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

## Overview of Bill

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to make minor amendments to various Acts—Schedule 1, and
- (b) to amend certain other Acts and instruments for the purpose of effecting statute law revision—Schedule 2, and
- (c) to make other provisions of a consequential or ancillary nature—Schedule 3.

## Outline of provisions

**Clause 1** sets out the name, also called the short title, of the proposed Act.

**Clause 2** provides for the commencement of the proposed Act.

**Clause 3** makes clear that the explanatory notes contained in the schedules do not form part of the proposed Act.

The regulations are currently due to be repealed on 1 September 2026 but continue to be required. The repeals are proposed to be further postponed for the following reasons—	15 16
(a) The Department of Communities and Justice is undertaking a review of the out-of-home care system, which may identify potential amendments to the <i>Adoption Act 2000</i> . It is therefore considered premature to remake the <i>Adoption Regulation 2015</i> .	17 18 19
(b) Transport for NSW is undertaking a review of bus industry policy to identify potential amendments to the <i>Passenger Transport Act 2014</i> (the <b>PT Act</b> ). The potential amendments may impact the in-force status of the <i>Air Transport Act 1964</i> , which is due to be repealed on the commencement of the PT Act, section 179.
