 - (3) An act is done in response to extreme provocation (despite subsection (2)) if:
 - (a) the act of the accused that causes death was in response to conduct of the deceased towards or affecting the accused that comprised or included domestic violence, and
 - (b) the act was done under provocation within the meaning of this section as in force immediately before its substitution by the *Crimes Amendment (Provocation) Act 2014*.
- No. 2 Page 3, Schedule 1. Insert after line 38:

domestic violence means the commission of any domestic violence offence within the meaning of the Crimes (Domestic and Personal Violence) Act 2007.
