37DA Information about energy sources

- (1) A retailer must publish on the retailer's website information about the sources of electricity provided by the retailer.
- (2) A bill for the supply of electricity prepared by a retailer for a small customer in accordance with the *National Energy Retail Rules* must include information about the sources of electricity provided by the retailer.
- (3) The information required by this section to be published or included in a bill must be sufficient to enable a customer or potential customer of the retailer to determine the relative percentages of electricity provided by renewable and non-renewable energy sources.
- (4) The information required by this section to be included in a bill must be displayed in a prominent position on the front page of the bill.
- (5) A retailer who fails, without reasonable excuse, to comply with this section is guilty of an offence.

Maximum penalty: \$11,000.
