Penalty Notices Validation Bill 2000

Act No , 2000

An Act to validate the issue of certain penalty notices.

I have examined this Bill, and find it to correspond in all respects with the Bill as finally passed by both Houses.

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Penalty Notices Validation Act 2000*.

2 Commencement

This Act is taken to have commenced on the day on which the Bill for this Act was first introduced into the Legislative Assembly.

3 Validation

- (1) Any penalty notice issued under section 18B of the *Traffic Act 1909* during the relevant period by an employee of a local council who could validly have issued the notice had the council been authorised by the Commissioner of Police for the purposes of Regulation 130A (1) (f1) of the *Motor Traffic Regulations 1935* at the time of issue, is taken at the time of issue and at all relevant times after the issue to have been validly issued.
- (2) In this section, *relevant period* means the period commencing on 22 June 1995 and ending with 24 March 1999, inclusive.
