Government Information (Public Access) (Consequential Amendments and Repeal) Bill 2009

Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament. This Bill is cognate with the *Government Information (Public Access) Bill 2009*.

Overview of Bill

The objects of this Bill are:

- (a) to transfer provisions concerning the amendment of personal records from the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* to the *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998*, and
- (b) to repeal the Freedom of Information Act 1989, and
- (c) to make miscellaneous amendments to other legislation as a consequence of the enactment of the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009*.

Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name (also called the short title) of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act on a day or days to be appointed by proclamation.

Clause 3 repeals the Freedom of Information Act 1989.

Schedule 1 contains amendments to the <i>Freedom of Information Act 1989</i> relating to the transfer of provisions concerning the amendment of personal records from that Act to the <i>Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998</i> . Schedule 2 amends the legislation specified in that Schedule, as a consequence of the enactment of the <i>Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009</i> .
