Proposed amendments

- No. 1 Page 2, clause 3, lines 10 and 11. Omit ", or another jurisdiction prescribed by the regulations".
- No. 2 Page 3. Insert after line 13:

5 Power to refuse mutual recognition

- (1) The local licensing authority for a local licence that is equivalent to a recognised licence may for any reason refuse mutual recognition of the recognised licence, and if the local licensing authority does so must give notice in writing of the refusal to the holder of the recognised licence.
- (2) Despite any other provision of this Act, a person does not hold a deemed local licence if the local licensing authority has refused mutual recognition of the recognised licence to which the local licence is equivalent.
- (3) A local licensing authority may at any time withdraw a refusal of mutual recognition of a recognised licence by notice in writing to the holder of the recognised licence.
- No. 3 Page 5, clause 14, lines 11 and 14. Omit "5 years" wherever occurring. Insert instead "3 years".
- No. 4 Page 7, Schedule 2, lines 2–8. Omit all words on those lines.
- No. 5 Page 7, Schedule 2, lines 9 and 10. Omit all words on those lines.
- No. 6 Page 7, Schedule 2, lines 11–22. Omit all words on those lines. Note. Amendment No 6 should not be moved unless amendment No 4 is successful.
