Proposed amendments

- No. 1 Eligibility for re-integration home detention orders
 - Page 3, Schedule 1 [3], proposed section 124B, lines 23-41. Omit all words on those lines.
- No. 2 Notice of refusal of re-integration home detention order
 - Page 5, Schedule 1 [3], proposed section 124E. Insert after line 4:
 - (2) The Parole Authority must notify the offender of a refusal to make a re-integration home detention order in the manner prescribed by the regulations. The notice is to set out the reasons for the decision recorded under section 193C.
- No. 3 Matters for consideration in granting parole
 - Page 9, Schedule 1 [12], proposed section 135, line 20. Insert "relating to the promotion of community safety, while recognising that the rehabilitation and re-integration of the offender into the community may be highly relevant to the promotion of community safety" after "principal matters".
