Uranium Mining and Nuclear Facilities (Prohibitions) Repeal Bill 2019

Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to repeal the *Uranium Mining and Nuclear Facilities (Prohibitions) Act* 1986

Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name (also called the short title) of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act on the date of assent to the proposed Act.

Clause 3 repeals the Uranium Mining and Nuclear Facilities (Prohibitions) Act 1986.

Clause 4 repeals section 10A of the *Mining Act 1992* which provides that a mining authorisation (other than an exploration licence or an environmental assessment permit relating to an exploration licence) may not be granted in respect of uranium.

Clause 5 repeals references to the *Uranium Mining and Nuclear Facilities (Prohibitions) Act* 1986 from the *Land and Environment Court Act* 1979.
