# Uranium Mining and Nuclear Facilities (Prohibitions) Repeal Bill 2019

## Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

## Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to repeal the *Uranium Mining and Nuclear Facilities (Prohibitions) Act 1986*.

## Outline of provisions

**Clause 1** sets out the name (also called the short title) of the proposed Act.

**Clause 2** provides for the commencement of the proposed Act on the date of assent to the proposed Act.

**Clause 3** repeals the *Uranium Mining and Nuclear Facilities (Prohibitions) Act 1986*.

**Clause 4** repeals section 10A of the *Mining Act 1992* which provides that a mining authorisation (other than an exploration licence or an environmental assessment permit relating to an exploration licence) may not be granted in respect of uranium.

**Clause 5** repeals references to the *Uranium Mining and Nuclear Facilities (Prohibitions) Act 1986* from the *Land and Environment Court Act 1979*.
