Proposed amendments

- No. 1 **Criminal offences**
Page 9, proposed Schedule 2.1[2], line 9. Omit “**by unqualified persons**”.
- No. 2 **Criminal offences**
Page 9, proposed Schedule 2.1[2], line 10. Omit “**performed by unqualified person**”.
- No. 3 **Criminal offences**
Page 9, proposed Schedule 2.1[2], line 17. Omit “subsection (2)”. Insert “this section”..
- No. 4 **Criminal offences**
Page 9, proposed Schedule 2.1[2]. Insert after line 24—
- (4) A medical practitioner who performs a termination on a person other than in accordance with the *Reproductive Health Care Reform Act 2019* commits an offence.
Maximum penalty—7 years imprisonment.
 - (5) A registered health practitioner who assists in the performance of a termination on a person that the registered health practitioner knows, or ought reasonably to know, is being performed other than in accordance with the *Reproductive Health Care Reform Act 2019* commits an offence.
Maximum penalty—7 years imprisonment.

Page 9, proposed Schedule 2.1[2]. Insert after line 31—
registered health practitioner means a person registered under the Health Practitioner Registration National Law to practise a health profession, other than as a student.
