Proposed amendments

No. 1 **Termination not to be used for sex selection**

Page 7, proposed section 14, line 12. Omit "gender". Insert instead "sex".

No. 2 **Termination not to be used for sex selection**

Page 7, proposed section 14, line 16. Omit "gender". Insert instead "sex".

No. 3 **Termination not to be used for sex selection**

Page 7, proposed section 15, lines 23–25. Omit all words on those lines. Insert instead—

15 Termination for sex selection not authorised

- (1) To avoid doubt, nothing in this Act authorises the performance of a termination for the sole purpose of sex selection.
- (2) However, a termination is not performed for the purpose of sex selection if it is performed because the foetus is confirmed or suspected to have a sex-linked genetic disorder.
- (3) Nothing in this section imposes any additional duty on a medical practitioner to investigate the purpose for which a termination is requested.
