**4.2A Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 No 203**

**Section 4.55 Modification of consents—generally**

Insert after subsection (1A)—

**(1B) Modifications involving the playing and performance of music**

If the consent authority is a council, all conditions of a development consent relating to the performance of music on licensed premises may, by notice published on the council's website, be modified to declare the conditions do not apply to—

- (a) the local government area, or
  - (b) a specified use of land in the local government area, or
  - (c) a suburb in the local government area.
- (1C) Subsection (1B) does not apply to a condition in relation to noise.
- (1D) A notice under subsection (1B) is taken to have effect the day the notice is published, or a later date specified by the notice.
- (1E) Subsections (1), (1A) and (2) do not apply to a modification under subsection (1B).
