- (3C) The Minister must not recommend to the Governor that a regulation be made under this section that expands the use of postal voting or postpones the conduct of an election unless the Minister has given a report to the Presiding Officer of each House of Parliament containing the advice of the following persons that the regulation is necessary—
 - (a) the Chief Health Officer,
 - (b) the Electoral Commissioner.
- (3D) A copy of a report given to the Presiding Officer of a House of Parliament under subsection (3C) must be laid before that House within 5 sitting days of that House after it is received by the Presiding Officer.
