No. 1 Offence of displaying Nazi symbols

Page 3, Schedule 1[2], line 8, proposed section 93ZA. Omit all words on that line. Insert instead—

(1) A person is guilty of an offence if the person, by a public act, displays a Nazi symbol with the intention of inciting, or while being reckless as to inciting, hatred towards, serious contempt for, or severe ridicule of, a person or group of persons.

No. 2 Offence of displaying Nazi symbols

Page 3, Schedule 1[2], lines 13–24, proposed section 93ZA(2)–(4). Omit all words on those lines.

No. 3 Offence of displaying Nazi symbols

Page 3, Schedule 1[2], proposed section 93ZA. Insert after line 30—

- (6A) This section does not apply to a public act done reasonably and in good faith for a purpose in the public interest, including the following—
 - (a) academic purposes,
 - (b) artistic purposes,
 - (c) scientific purposes,
 - (d) research purposes,
 - (e) discussion or debate.
