No. 1 Voluntary assisted dying substance

Page 3, clause 7(2). Insert after line 33—

(1A) The Health Secretary may approve a poison under subsection (1) only if the poison is listed in the Australian Register of Therapeutic Goods, maintained under the *Therapeutic Goods Act 1989* of the Commonwealth, section 9A for the specific indication of causing a patient's death.

No. 2 Voluntary assisted dying—suicide

Page 5, clause 12(1), lines 29–31. Omit all words on those lines.

No. 3 Voluntary assisted dying—suicide (only to be moved if amendment No. 2 not successful)

Page 5, clause 12. Insert after line 31-

- (1A) Despite subsection (1)—
 - (a) the death of a person by self-administration of a prescribed substance may still be included as a suicide in a statistical report prepared by the Crown or a person or body acting on behalf of the Crown, and
 - (b) a strategy to prevent or reduce the number of persons committing suicide adopted by the Crown or a person or body acting on behalf of the Crown may include measures to prevent or reduce the number of deaths of persons by self-administration of a prescribed substance.
