#### 47D Restrictions on use of cash

If approved gaming machines are located in a hotel or the premises of a club, the hotelier or club must not accept more than \$1,000 cash from a customer in a day for the use of a gaming machine for the purposes of gambling.

Maximum penalty—1,000 penalty units.
