Port of Newcastle (Extinguishment of Liability) Bill 2022

Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to extinguish certain liabilities of the operator of the Port of Newcastle relating to an agreement between the State and the operator of Port Botany and Port Kembla.

Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name, also called the short title, of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act on the date of assent to the proposed Act.

Clause 3 provides that the Act binds the Crown.

Clause 4 extinguishes the operator of the Port of Newcastle's liability to reimburse the State for payments the State must make to another port operator.
