No. 1 Port operator may request public interest assessment

In Opposition amendment No. 1, insert after proposed clause 5 the following—

5A Port operator may request public interest assessment

An operating entity associated with the Port of Newcastle may, by written notice to the Treasurer, request that the Treasurer require an independent person to provide a report under section 6(1).

No. 2 Treasurer must require public interest assessment

In Opposition amendment No. 1, proposed clause 6(1), omit "may require". Insert instead the words "must, within 28 days of receiving a request under section 5A, require".

No. 3 Consideration of benefits to State

In Opposition amendment No. 1, insert after proposed clause 6(3)(d)—

- (e) whether the construction of the container terminal would deliver a broader benefit to the State, including whether or not the construction would—
 - (i) enable more freight to be carried by means other than road, and
 - (ii) enable economic diversification for the Newcastle and Hunter Valley region to occur more quickly than if the container terminal were not constructed.
