326A Disclosure of threats or actions against legal practitioners

A person is taken to have waived legal professional privilege, or the benefit of any duty of confidentiality—

- (a) in relation to a threat made, or action taken, by the person against an Australian legal practitioner if the threat or action may constitute an offence against section 322 or 326, and
- (b) to enable the Australian legal practitioner to disclose to the appropriate authorities information necessary for investigating and dealing with the threat or action.
