The object of this Bill is to appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund the following sums for the recurrent services and capital works and services for the year 1999–2000 of the offices specified:

An Act to appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund sums for the recurrent services and capital works and services of certain offices for the year 1999–2000.

Clause 1 Appropriation (Special Offices) Bill 1999

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Appropriation (Special Offices) Act 1999.

2 Commencement

This Act commences or is taken to have commenced on 1 July 1999.

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3 Interpretation

- (1) In this Act, a reference to the year 1999–2000 is a reference to the year from 1 July 1999 to 30 June 2000.
- (2) A reference in the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983* to an or the Appropriation Act includes a reference to this Act.

4 Appropriation from Consolidated Fund 1999–2000 for recurrent services of certain offices

- (1) Out of the Consolidated Fund there are hereby appropriated the sums identified in sections 6 and 7 as the sums appropriated by this Act for recurrent services, which sums may be issued and applied for or towards the several uses and purposes expressed in those sections for the ordinary annual services of the Government for the year 1999–2000.
- (2) The total sum appropriated out of the Consolidated Fund for the ordinary annual services of the Government for the year 1999–2000, in accordance with the provisions of sections 6 and 7 is the sum of \$82,186,000.
- (3) Any amounts expended for recurrent services under section 25 of the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983* or any Supply Act on or after 1 July 1999 and before the date of assent to this Act are taken to have been expended out of such of the sums for recurrent services set out in sections 6 and 7 as may be determined by the Treasurer.
