Cattle Compensation Repeal Bill 2001

Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to repeal the *Cattle Compensation Act 1951* and the *Cattle Compensation (Advisory Council) Regulation 1999*.

The Bill does not contain any savings or transitional provisions consequent on the repeal of the *Cattle Compensation Act 1951* as there is no longer any money standing to the credit of the Cattle Compensation Fund established under that Act.

Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name (also called the short title) of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 repeals the *Cattle Compensation Act 1951* and the *Cattle Compensation (Advisory Council) Regulation 1999*.
