Proposed amendments

- No. 1 Page 6, Schedule 1 [2]. Insert after line 24:
- (f) to prioritise the procurement of goods and services that are Australian made,
 - (g) to ensure goods and services procured by and for government agencies:
 - (i) meet fair trade standards, in the case of imported goods and services, and
 - (ii) are supplied by enterprises that comply with International Labour Organisation standards (including in relation to child labour), and
 - (iii) are produced without the use of child labour, and
 - (iv) are produced in compliance with applicable animal welfare laws and best practice,
 - (h) to ensure the procurement of goods and services by and for government agencies is carried out in a way which respects the culture of Indigenous peoples,
 - (i) to maximise the re-use and recycling of goods that are unserviceable or no longer required,
 - (j) to require government agencies to meet high environmental standards in the procurement of goods and services, including in relation to waste production, energy efficiency and re-using and recycling goods,
 - (k) to prioritise the procurement of goods and services from suppliers that have an Extended Producer Responsibility strategy.
- No. 2 Page 11, Schedule 1 [4], line 12. Insert “or if the matter concerns a complaint against the government agency to which the member belongs” after “an interest”.
