Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

This Bill is cognate with the Appropriation Bill 2000.

Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund the following sums for the recurrent services and capital works and services of the Legislature for the year 2000–01.

Recurrent Services \$64,961,000 Capital Works and Services \$4,121,000 The amount appropriated is intended to be applied to the following services/functions:
