Insert as section 11D:

11D Air quality management in casino private gaming area

- (1) The casino operator must maintain dedicated resources for appropriately managing, setting performance benchmarks for and monitoring indoor air quality in a casino private gaming area at the casino.
- (2) The casino operator must establish, maintain and implement an air quality management plan that documents the way in which indoor air quality will be maintained in a casino private gaming area at the casino. The management plan must include performance benchmarks and testing and monitoring regimes.
- (3) The casino operator must conduct a regular review of its air quality management plan for a casino private gaming area at the casino.
- (4) The casino operator must conduct monthly testing of the indoor air quality in a casino private gaming area at the casino. Testing must be by an independent person with appropriate skills. The results of testing must be provided to each director of the casino operator for review.
- (5) The casino operator must make reasonable efforts (by rostering and like practices) to minimise the actual time employees work in a casino private gaming area at the casino.

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- (6) The casino operator must on a regular basis provide information to its employees demonstrating compliance by the casino operator with this section.
 - (7) The casino operator must report to the Minister on a quarterly basis demonstrating compliance by the casino operator with this section.
 - (8) It is a condition of a casino operator's licence under the *Casino Control Act 1992* that the casino operator must comply with the requirements of this section.
 - (9) A report on compliance by the casino operator with this section is to be tabled by the Minister in each House of Parliament no later than 1 June in each year. The report is to comprise a compilation of the reports provided by the casino operator to the Minister under this section for the 4 quarters before the report is tabled in Parliament.
 - (10) In this section:
casino operator means the person who is the holder of the casino licence under the *Casino Control Act 1992* for a casino.
