**Proposed amendments to Opposition amendments on sheet c2012-118A**

- No. 1      Amendment to Opposition amendment No.2. Omit proposed section 11D (1). Insert instead:
- (1) The Director-General is to set performance benchmarks for indoor air quality in a casino private gaming area and must ensure that those benchmarks are compliant with any standards for indoor air quality set by the World Health Organisation.
- No. 2      Amendment to Opposition amendment No.2. Omit proposed section 11D (2). Insert instead:
- (2) The casino operator must establish, maintain and implement an air quality management plan that:
    - (a) has been certified by the Director-General, and
    - (b) documents the way in which indoor air quality will be maintained in a casino private gaming area at the casino in accordance with performance benchmarks set by the Director-General, and
    - (c) includes testing and monitoring regimes.
- No. 3      Amendment to Opposition amendment No.2. Omit proposed section 11D (3). Insert instead:
- (3) The Director-General must conduct a regular review of the certification of an air quality management plan for a casino private gaming area.
- No. 4      Amendment to Opposition amendment No.2. Omit proposed section 11D (4). Insert instead:
- (4) The Director-General must conduct monthly testing of the indoor air quality in a casino private gaming area at the casino and for that purpose is entitled to enter the casino private gaming area whenever gaming is being conducted there.
- No. 5      Amendment to Opposition amendment No.2. Insert after proposed section 11D (4):
- (5) The Director-General is entitled to recover from the casino operator the reasonable expenses incurred by the
