

# **Children's Court Amendment Bill 2000**

## **Explanatory note**

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

#### Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to amend the *Children's Court Act 1987* to enable rules to be made conferring functions of the Children's Court or Children's Magistrates under the *Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1998*, and related functions under the *Children's Court Act 1987*, on Children's Registrars.

### Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name (also called the short title) of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act immediately after the commencement of Schedule 1 [7] to the *Children and Young Persons Legislation (Repeal and Amendment) Act 1998.* That provision inserts proposed section 10A into the *Children's Court Act 1987* which provides for the appointment of Children's Registrars.

**Clause 3** is a formal provision giving effect to the amendment to the *Children's Court Act 1987* set out in Schedule 1.

#### Schedule 1 Amendment

**Schedule 1** contains the amendment set out in the Overview above.
