## ECONOMIC STABILITY AND WAR-TIME PROVISIONS CONTINUANCE BILL:—

Clauses 1. to 9 having been dealt with,—

Clause 10. (1) The Governor may, after consultation has taken place between Regulations, the Premier of the State and the Prime Minister of the Commonwealth, make regulations—

- (a) for or in respect of any matters or class of matters dealt with in any Commonwealth Regulations in operation by virtue of section three of this Act;
- (b) repealing or amending any regulations in operation by virtue of this Part of this Act but so that any such amendment shall be in respect of a matter dealt with by those regulations.

(2) The regulations made under this section may provide for empowering such persons or classes of persons as are prescribed and thereto authorised in pursuance of the regulations, to make orders, rules or other instruments for any of the purposes for which regulations are, by this Part of this Act, authorised to be made.

(3) The regulations made under this section shall—

- (a) be published in the Gazette;
- (b) take effect from the date of publication or from a later date to be specified in the regulations; and
- (c) be laid before both Houses of Parliament within fourteen sitting days after publication if Parliament is then in session, and if not, then within fourteen sitting days after the commencement of the next session.

If either House of Parliament passes a resolution of which notice has been given at any time within fifteen sitting days after such regulations have been laid before such House disallowing any regulation or part thereof, such regulation or part shall thereupon cease to have effect.

## INDUSTRIAL ARBITRATION (FORTY HOURS WEEK) AMENDMENT BILL:—

Clause 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Industrial Arbitration (Forty Hours Week) Amendment Act, 1947." Short title,  
commencement, etc.

(2) The Industrial Arbitration Act, 1940, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Industrial Arbitration Act, 1940-1947.

(3) This Act shall commence upon the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, or upon such earlier day as may be appointed by the Governor and notified by proclamation published in the Gazette. [Read.]

(f) Where in any industry the ordinary time of work was at the commencement of the Industrial Arbitration (Forty Hours Week) Amendment Act, 1947, fixed by award or agreement or by well-established practice in the industry, such time shall not be exceeded thereafter in respect of such industry.

(12) The Commission may, in any industry or in respect of any employees or class of employees in any industry, declare a lesser number of ordinary working hours than the standard hours about to be declared or already declared if the Commission is of the opinion that productive efficiency or output will be maintained in that industry or by those employees or that class of employees, and that such reduction of hours will be in the public interest."
