BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Water (Amendment) Act, 1916." **2.** Short title.

2. The "Water Act, 1912," is amended as follows:—

- (a) In section thirty-five omit the words "out of the funds raised under this Part, or out of the revenue account or the loan account of the Public Works Fund"; and at the end of the section add the words "The cost of carrying out such works may be defrayed from such Loan Votes as are now or may hereafter be applicable to the purpose or from the Public Works Fund."
- (b) In sections sixty-six and sixty-seven respectively omit the words "out of the funds raised under this Part", and substitute the words "out of such Loan Votes as are now or may hereafter be applicable to the purpose."
- (c) Sections sixty-eight and sixty-nine are repealed.
