Act No. 37, 1916.

An Act to amend the Weights and Measures Act, 1915; to suspend the operation of the said Act; to re-enact and continue the provisions of the Acts thereby repealed. [Assented to, 12th September, 1916.]

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the "Weights and Short title. Measures (Amendment) Act, 1916." The

Weights and Measures (Amendment).

The sections, Schedules, and other provisions referred to in this Act are those contained in the Weights and Measures Act, 1915.

2. (1) In subsection one of section one of the Weights and Measures Act, 1915, omit "first day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen," insert "first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen."

(2) The operation of the Weights and Measures Act, 1915, is hereby suspended until the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, and the enactments repealed by the said Act are hereby re-enacted and shall continue in force until the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, and no longer.

3. The Weights and Measures Act, 1915, is amended as follows :—

- (1) Section three : Omit section.
 - (2) Section four: Omit "Inspector-General" insert in lieu thereof "Minister".
 - (3) Section six :
 - (a) Omit the definition of "Inspector-General".
 - (b) In the definition of "superintendent" after the words "means superintendent" insert "of weights and measures".
 - (4) Section seven: Omit "Inspector-General, a".
 - (5) Section eight: Omit all the words after "the superintendent" insert in lieu thereof "and such inspectors as may be necessary".
 - (6) Sections nine, ten and eleven: Omit the word "Inspector-General" wherever it occurs in the sections and insert in lieu thereof the word "Minister."
 - (7) Section sixteen: Omit "the same" insert "weights and measures of such denominations".
 - (8) Section twenty-six: After "seller" in each instance insert "or the person offering or exposing such article for sale"
- (9) Section twenty-eight: After "sell" in fifth line insert "or deliver". Delete "or" where secondly occurring in sixth line, and after "measure" in sixth line insert "or number"

These fees include the stamping of one set of proportional weights where such are used ; duplex sets to be charged half fees.

One-half of those fees to be chargeable for weights, measures, or weighing instruments tested and rejected as incorrect or otherwise unsuitable: Provided that where fractions of a penny occur they shall be charged as one penny.

In the case of weighing instruments graduated in centals, read "100 lb." in place of "1 cwt."

For the testing of weighing instruments at premises outside the inspector's office, owners shall provide cartage for the necessary weights, and the labour required to handle them, and shall pay any additional mileage fees prescribed by the regulations.

7. In Schedule E insert after the line "Beans, 60 lb." the following :-- "Beans (fresh), 20 lb."; and after the line "Peas, 60 lb." insert the following :-- "Peas (in pod), 28 lb."


