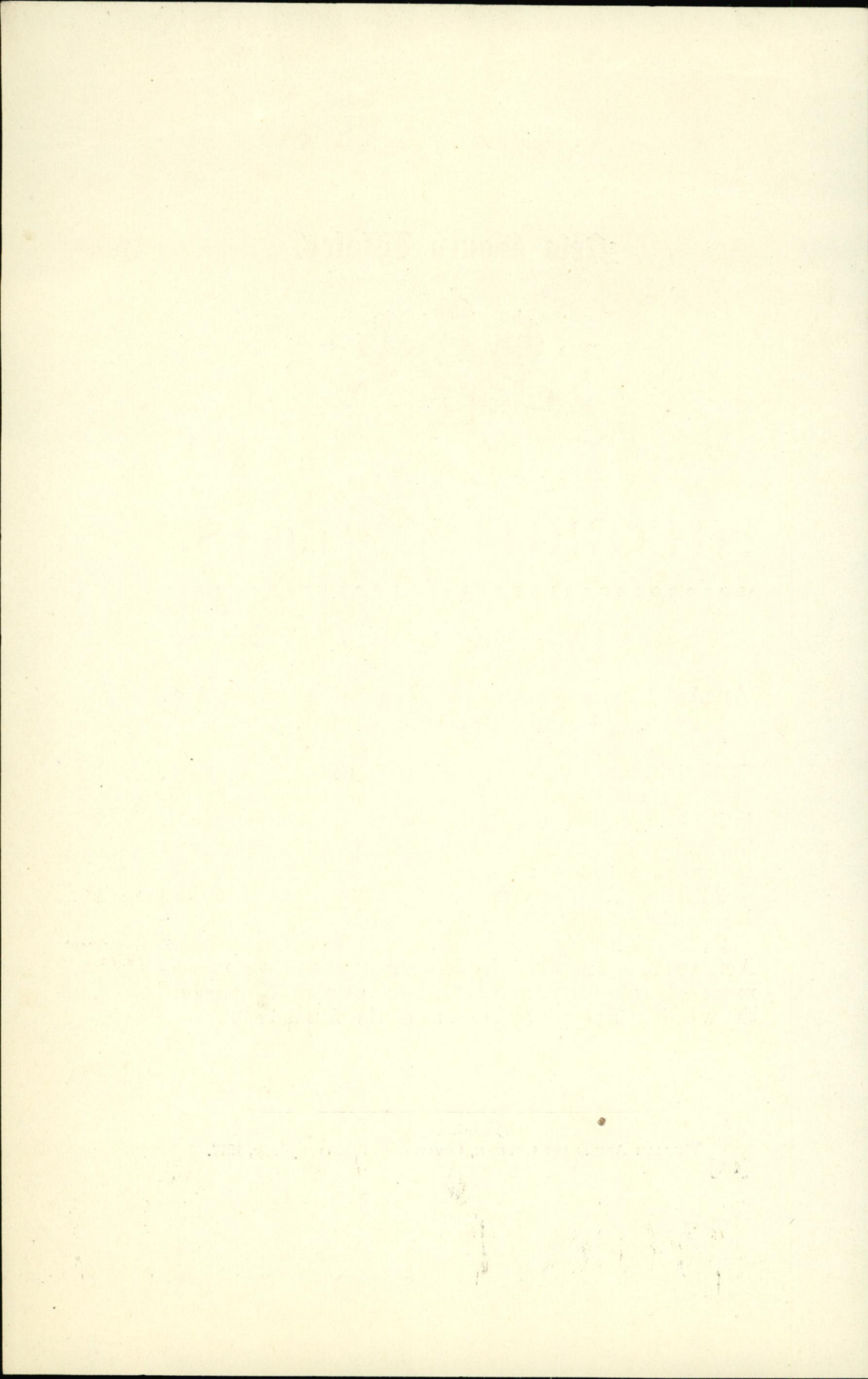
1. This Act may be cited as the "Coal Mines Regulation (Amendment) Act, 1917." Short title.
