Act No. 4, 1919.

An Act to write off a part of the debt of the Council of the Municipality of Cobar, in respect of works of water supply. [Assented to, 10th November, 1919.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Cobar Water Short title. Supply (Reduction of Debt) Act, 1919."
