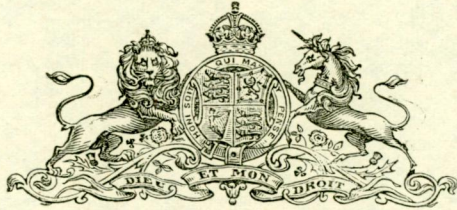

1. This Act may be cited as the "Income Tax Act, 1918".
2. The amount in the fourth which constitutes the income tax imposed on any taxable income by the Income Tax Act, 1917, as amended by the Income Tax (Amendment) Act, 1917, and the Income Tax (Amendment) Act, 1917, is hereby, with respect to the income tax payable in the year one thousand nine hundred and nineteen, increased by the sum of threepence.
