Act No. 34, 1919.

An Act to amend the Newcastle District Abattoir and Saleyards Act, 1912, as amended by the Newcastle District Abattoir and Saleyards Amendment Act, 1915. [Assented to, 16th December, 1919.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Newcastle District Abattoir and Saleyards Amendment Act, 1919." Short title.

2. Section thirteen of the Newcastle Abattoir and Saleyards Act, 1912, as amended by the Newcastle District Abattoir and Saleyards Amendment Act, 1915, is amended as follows:—After "provided" insert "and for additions and improvements to such abattoir and saleyards, and for any other of the board's authorised purposes or objects"; omit the words "one hundred and twenty" and insert in lieu thereof the words "one hundred and fifty-five." Amendment of No. 49, 1912, s. 13. Increase of sum board empowered to borrow.


