WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble. loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Five millions three hundred and forty-six thousand seven hundred and thirty-five pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund the sum of One million six hundred and eighty thousand pounds.
